Composite Bonding

Composite bonding is a cosmetic technique that shapes and molds composite resin on your teeth to make you smile look straighter and whiter. It can be used to fix teeth that are chipped, stained, or have gaps between them. Composite resin bonding can often be completed in one appointment and is geared towards patients searching for a cosmetic solution for otherwise healthy teeth.

Tooth Recontouring

Tooth recontouring - also called tooth reshaping, slenderizing, enameloplasty, odontoplasty, or stripping - consists of removing small amounts of tooth enamel to change the length, surface, and shape of a tooth. Tooth recontouring can be used to correct minor imperfections such as small chips, correcting pointy teeth, adjusting slight irregularities in tooth shapes, smoothing out pits or grooves in tooth enamel, or adjusting tooth length.

Smile Whitening

Tooth whitening, also known as tooth bleaching, refers to the process of lightening the color of your teeth and is often desirable for those whose teeth have become yellowed over time. It can be achieved by changing the extrinsic (external) or the intrinsic (internal) color of your tooth's enamel. At Signature Smiles, we offer both in-office and take-home smile whitening options.

They also act as a protective layer to keep your teeth safe from damage and can change the color, shape, size, or length of your teeth.

Benefits of a Veneer:

- Porcelain veneers can fix teeth that have been stained because of root canal treatment, excessive fluoride, resin fillings, use of tetracycline or other drugs, and a variety of other causes.

- They can also help make your smile whiter and are resistant to staining.
- Veneers look natural and blend in well with your teeth.
- They interact well with your gums.
- Porcelain veneers generally do not have to be shaped as much as crowns do.

Minimal Prep Veneers

As opposed to no-prep veneers which generally need no or very limited change to the structure of your teeth, minimal prep veneers require that a small amount of tooth enamel is removed. These veneers also require that the structure of the tooth is reshaped to allow for an even fit. Minimal prep veneers are more common than no-prep veneers, often have a longer lasting color, and provide a more permanent solution to tooth discoloration.

What is Restorative Dentistry?

Fillings

At Signature Smiles by Dr. Mike Schweizer, dental fillings are made from 100% composite material. Also referred to as tooth fillings or cavity fillings, dental fillings can be used as a solution to painful cavities. Dentists will remove the decayed portion of a tooth and then fill in that area with the appropriate material. Fillings can also be used to repair teeth that are broken, cracked, or worn down due to nail-biting, tooth grinding, or other forms of misuse.

Porcelain Inlays/Porcelain Onlays

Porcelain inlays and onlays are custom fillings that are permanently cemented to your teeth. Inlays are used to repair teeth with large fillings or that have been

damaged by decay or trauma. Onlays are used when one or more of your chewing cusps has been affected and also need to be restored. Both types can be used as a way of conservatively repairing teeth with broken fillings or teeth that have been damaged due to trauma or decay.

Crowns/Bridges

A dental crown can be used to cap a damaged or decayed tooth and can be placed on top of an implant to replace a missing tooth. Bridges are solely used as a replacement for one or more missing teeth. They feature one crown on either side of where the missing tooth should be and work by joining an artificial tooth to dental implants or adjacent teeth.

Dentures & Partials

Dentures are removable replacements for missing teeth as well as the surrounding tissue. Complete dentures can be used when all the teeth are missing, and partial dentures can be used when only some of the teeth are missing. Both complete and partial dentures consist of false teeth attached to a plastic base that is the same color as your gums.

Endodontics

Endodontics is the branch of dentistry that is concerned with the treatment and study of dental pulp. Endodontic treatment, also called root canal treatment, treats the soft pulp tissue that is inside of your teeth. A root canal consists of the removal of damaged or infected tooth pulp, cleaning and disinfecting your root canal system, filling it in, sealing it, and placing a composite filling or crown over it.

Oral Surgery

Oral surgery, also called maxillofacial surgery, is a type of surgical specialty that focuses on reconstructing the face. Oral surgery may be a result of facial trauma, tooth loss caused by gum disease, or other dental issues. It can include the oral cavity, mouth, jaw, head, neck, and facial cosmetic surgery. This specialized type of dentistry may require additional training on top of a dentist's usual qualifications.

 - Dental X-rays, or radiographs, use low levels of radiation to capture images of your teeth. X-rays can help your dentist identify problems like tooth decay, cavities, and impacted teeth to better evaluate your oral health.
- Hygiene
 - Dental hygiene is the practice of keeping your teeth, gums, and mouth healthy and clean in order to prevent oral disease. It's an essential part of our everyday lives and can help prevent tooth decay and periodontal disease.
- Periodontal Therapy
 - Periodontal therapy encompasses an umbrella of terms for a variety of different treatments you may need to help treat gum disease. Also known as periodontal disease, gum disease is common but fairly preventable with the right care.
- Fluoride Treatments
 - Fluoride treatments use a highly concentrated rinse, varnish, gel, or foam that's applied with a brush, swab, tray, or as a mouthwash. Your dentist may ask you to avoid eating or drinking for half an hour after treatment.
- Mouthguards
 - Mouthguards, also called mouth protectors, are designed to help lessen facial trauma and minimize the risk of broken teeth and lip, tongue, or jaw injuries. They usually cover a patient's upper teeth and can protect soft mouth tissue.
- Anesthesia
 - Dental anesthesia is a type of controlled substance that temporarily puts the patient to sleep or numbs an area to reduce pain. Sedation dentistry uses anesthesia to help lessen discomfort, to control pain, and makes the patient feel more relaxed.
- TMJ Treatment
 - Temporomandibular joint dysfunction, also called TMJ or TMJ dysfunction, is related to problems with your jaw as well as the muscles in your face that control it. Common treatments for TMJ include medications, physical therapy, and bite guards.
- Sleep Apnea Treatment
 - Sleep apnea is a disorder marked by breathing that stops and starts. Signs may include loud snoring and feeling tired after a full night of sleep. Treatment may require lifestyle changes like weight loss or use of breathing machines.
- Emergency Care
